Nigerian Market Highlight: Equity, Fixed Income & Money Market Review

TUESDAY, 16th SEPTEMBER 2025

Equities Market

- At the close of trading on the Nigerian Stock Exchange (NGX) today, 414.98 million shares worth №12.94 billion were exchanged in 25,383 deals - reflecting a 25% decline in volume, a 46% drop in turnover, and a 20% decrease in deals compared to the previous session. Market capitalization stood at ¥89.6 trillion.
- Out of 128 traded equities, 23 advanced while 27 declined. Custodian & Allied led the gainers with a 9.94% rise to ¥44.80, trailed by Multiverse Mining & Exploration (+9.68%), Eunisell Interlinked (+9.45%), and E-Tranzact International (+9.45%). On the other hand, Austin Laz & Company topped the losers' chart with a 6.27% decline to ¥2.69, followed by Deap Capital Management & Trust (-5.56%), FTN Cocoa Processors (-4.84%), and Regency Alliance Insurance (-4.40%).
- Guaranty Trust Holding posted the highest activity with 32.9 million units traded, while Secure Electronic Technology (32.5m), United Bank for Africa (26.2m), and Chams (22m) followed.

Treasury Bills Market

The treasury bills secondary market traded actively with a bearish note ahead of today's NTB auction. Interest was concentrated in the 3-Sep bill as well as the Jan-Apr OMO papers, while the average rate closed at 17.21%.

Bonds Market

The FGN bonds secondary market traded quietly with a bullish undertone, as activity was concentrated in the 2029s, 2031s, and 2033s. Average yield slipped 2bps to 16.44%.


