Nigerian Market Highlight: Equity, Fixed Income & Money Market Review

Equities Market

- The Nigerian Stock Exchange (NGX) closed its first weekday session with a total of 624.6 million shares traded in 31,531 deals, amounting to a market value of NGN 13.47 billion. This reflects a 62% increase in trading volume, a 29% rise in turnover, and a 45% uptick in the number of deals compared to the previous trading day.
- Out of 129 equities that traded, 24 recorded gains while 26 declined. Sovereign Trust Insurance led the gainers with a 9.97% increase to NGN 3.53 per share, followed by Transcorp Power, Consolidated Hallmark Holdings, and Haldane McCall. On the losing side, Regency Alliance Insurance dropped the most, down 17.58% to NGN 1.36.
- Consolidated Hallmark Holdings posted the highest volume of shares traded at 210 million, trailed by Fidelity Bank with 47.5 million, Chams with 44 million, and Universal Insurance Company with 29.9 million shares.

Fixed Income and Money Market

Money Market

 System liquidity opened at №2.03 trillion long. The OBB and OVN rates stood at 24.50% and 24.90%, respectively.

Treasury Bills Market

• The Treasury bills market opened the week mixed, as yields on long-dated papers moved in different directions. The 18-Jun-26 and 08-Oct-26 bills recorded slight declines, while the 23-Jul-26 and 20-Aug-26 bills inched higher. Overall, the average yield rose by 1bp to 16.07%.

Bonds Market

The FGN bond market opened the week quiet, with trades focused on short- to mid-term maturities. The DMO also released its Q4 2025 issuance calendar, featuring re-openings of the AUG 2030 and JAN 2032 bonds. Overall, the average rate held steady at 15.98%.


